



## **COMCAST PARTNERS WITH POPE PARK AND CT PUERTO RICAN FORUM ON ANNUAL DAY OF COMMUNITY SERVICE**

***More Than 4,700 New England Volunteers Join Over 50,000 Nationwide  
On Seventh Annual Comcast Cares Day***

**HARTFORD, CT** – (May 3, 2008) – As part of Comcast Cares Day, one of the nation's largest single-day corporate volunteer efforts, local Comcast employees and their family members today gathered at Pope Park and the CT Puerto Rican Forum in Hartford to spruce up the facilities, working on various projects ranging from landscaping to painting.

Comcast volunteers, joined by Hartford Mayor Eddie Perez and Congressman John Larson, spent the day working to improve the two sites. At Pope Park, volunteers performed landscaping and painting projects and at the CT Puerto Rican Forum, volunteers worked on painting and refurbishing projects.
